## RECENT EVENTS:

### JUNE 19: A VISIT FROM PROF. FUMIHIKO NAKAMURA, EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR AND VICE PRESIDENT FROM YOKOHAMA NATIONAL UNIVERSITY (YNU)

On June 19th, 2018 Assoc. Prof. Dr. Pun Thongchumnum, Acting Vice President for Phuket Campus; Assoc. Prof. Dr. Prathana Kannaovakun, Acting Vice President for Academic Affairs; and other PSU Phuket representatives warmly welcomed Prof. Fumihiko Nakamura, Executive Director and Vice President from Yokohama National University (YNU) to PSU Phuket. The purpose of the visit was to discuss about possible academic collaboration including student exchange, short course programs and other activities between PSU and YNU. Prof. Nakamura also visited the PSU-YNU branch office located inside the International Affairs Centre (IAC), 2nd floor of the President's Office Building, (Bldg.7). This branch office has been set up since June 2017.



### JUNE 19 - 23: A VISIT FROM GUOKAI EDUCATION GROUP, CHINA

On June 19th - 23rd, 2018 Assoc. Prof. Dr. Pun Thongchumnum, Acting Vice President for Phuket Campus; Assoc. Prof. Dr. Prathana Kannaovakun, Acting Vice President for Academic Affairs; and other PSU Phuket representatives warmly welcomed Mr. Zang Yunwa, Director of International Education and delegates from Guokai Education Group, China to PSU Phuket. The meeting took place on the 3rd floor of the President's Office Building (Bldg.7) with all faculties and departments. The purpose of the visit was to discuss about the possible academic collaboration focusing on sending about 200 Chinese high school students to study at PSU Phuket for 4 years and other relevant details between PSU Phuket and Guokai. During the visit, they had a campus tour visiting all faculties and facilities. They also visited many tourist attractions in Phuket and tried some local Thai food.

Sirikit Kitiyakara (Thai: สิริกิติ์ กิติยากร: Sirikit Kitiyakon) born on 12 August 1932 is the queen mother of Thailand. She was the queen consort of King Bhumibol Adulyadej (or Rama IX) and is the mother of King Vajiralongkorn (or Rama X). She met Bhumibol in Paris, where her father was Thai ambassador. They married in 1950, shortly before Bhumibol's coronation. Sirikit was appointed queen regent in 1956, when the king entered the Buddhist monkhood for a period of time. Sirikit has one son and three daughters with the king. Consort of the monarch who was the world's longest-reigning head of state, she was also the world's longest-serving consort. Sirikit suffered a stroke on 21 July 2012 and has since refrained from public appearances.

### 90 DAY REPORT ONLINE!

Must be done 8 - 15 days **BEFORE** the 90 day due date stamped in your passport.

On the IAC website (<http://www.iac.phuket.psu.ac.th/>) under "Useful Information" you can find a link titled "Online 90 Day Report Instructions" to guide you to do the online 90 day report. You can also contact IAC for further information and if you have any questions.

**IMPORTANT: FULL-TIME INTERNATIONAL STAFF AND STUDENTS, PLEASE REMEMBER TO CHECK YOUR PASSPORT TO SEE WHEN YOU MUST DO YOUR 90 DAY REPORT EITHER ONLINE (8-15 DAYS BEFORE DUE DATE) OR AT THE IMMIGRATION OFFICE IN PHUKET TOWN.**
