

HOLIDAYS:

JULY

Friday 11 July: Asarnha Bucha Day

The day before full moon: Asarnha Bucha Day - This Buddhist holiday, also a public holiday throughout Thailand, commemorates the first sermon of the Buddha to his five disciples. Of the five, one asked to become a monk. This day is marked with candlelit processions. It deals with Buddha, Dharma and Sangha, the three Gems or Jewels of Buddhism.

AUGUST

Tuesday 12 August: Her Majesty the Queen's Birthday

Thais revere the Royal Family and the celebration of the Queen's Birthday, the mother of all mothers. This is a national holiday set aside for Thais to celebrate and express their respect and love for her and for their own mothers.

Saturday 12 July: Buddhist Lent Day (Holiday is Substituted on Monday 14 July)

Day after Asarnha Bucha Day:
Buddhist Lent Day - Asarnha Bucha
Day is a public holiday marking the
beginning of the 3 month Buddhist
rain retreat when traditionally
monks stay in the forest during the
duration of the rainy season. Monks
living in town are not allowed to
sleep outside their temple during
this period. Devotees buy big
candles to offer to the temples.





IAC'S MONTHLY TIPS:

Rainy Season is Upon Us For your safety PLEASE:

- 1) Wear your helmet at ALL times and bring a Rain Jacket while riding your motorcycle.
- Don't drive too fast, don't overtake in turns and be alert while driving your car or motorcycle.
- 3) Be careful for landslides.
- 4) Don't swim where there are RED flags on the beach.
- 5) Don't go out on a boat during rough seas and weather.
- 6) Be safe and use common sense.
