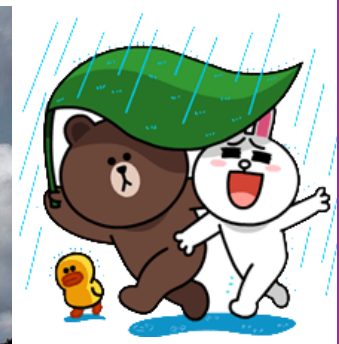
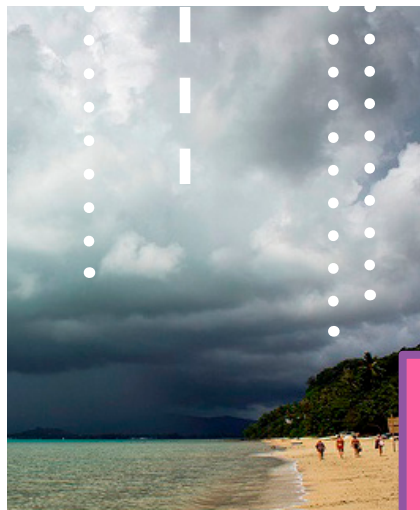
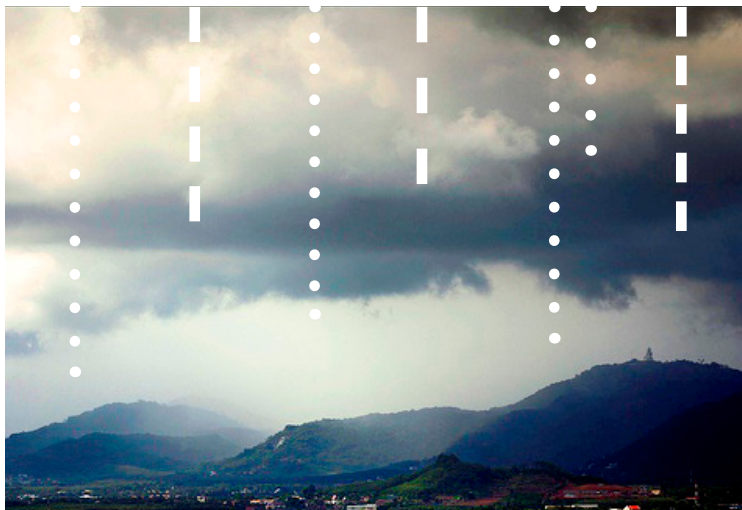
Monday 1 June: Visakha Bucha Day

Visakha Bucha Day in Buddhism commemorates the birth, enlightenment and the passing away of Gautama Buddha. The Buddha was born on this day in Lumpini, Nepal. 35 years later on this day he attained enlightenment in Bodhi Gaya, India. And 80 years after his birth, on the same day, the Buddha passed away in Kusinara (Kushinagar), India.

On Visakha Bucha Day, Buddhists offer alms to monks, visit temples, make merit, and observe meditation. The day is also a reminder to Buddhists of the Buddha's most important teachings.
