RECENT EVENTS:

FEBRUARY 8 & 24: A VISIT FROM GUOKAI EDUCATION GROUP, CHINA

On February 8th & 24th , 2018, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Worawut Wisutmethangoon, Vice President for Phuket Campus and other PSU Phuket representatives warmly welcomed delegates from Guokai Education Group, China: Prof. Zang Yun Wu and Mr. Paolo Antonelli to PSU Phuket to discuss possible collaboration such as opportunities for Guokai High School graduates to study at PSU, Phuket. Each faculty had the opportunity to discuss possible areas of collaboration. Guokai Education Group, China is planning on sending their students overseas and building a learning center at PSU Phuket. Guokai Education Group is one of the largest private fundamental education institutions in China and has 21 schools ranging from kindergarten to high school. Guokai has nearly 10,000 high school graduates every year.



FEBRUARY 12: AN ARRIVAL OF JAPANESE STUDENTS FROM BUNKYO UNIVERSITY, JAPAN

On February 12th, 2018, a group of 20 Japanese students from Bunkyo University arrived at Phuket International Airport to undertake a short course a 3-month "Short Course Program 2018" at PSU Phuket from February-May.













FEBRUARY 13: AN ORIENTATION FOR BUNKYO UNI-VERSITY STUDENTS, JAPAN

On February 13th, 2018, Assoc. Prof. Dr. Worawut Wisutmethangoon, Vice President for Phuket Campus and other PSU Phuket lecturers and staff welcomed a group of 20 Bunkyo University students from Japan who arrived in Phuket on Monday, 12 February, 2018 to undertake a 3-month "Short Course Program 2018" at PSU Phuket. They had an orientation in the morning arranged by IAC, where they were briefed about some basic facts about PSU and other important information for their stay here. IAC also gave a campus tour around the university.



FEBRUARY 21: THAI LANGUAGE COURSE 2018 FOR INTERNATIONAL STAFF & STUDENTS

On February 21st, 2018, IAC in coordination with FIS started "Thai Language Course 2018 for International Staff & Students" for beginners under the "International Campus Project." The purpose of this project is to improve International staff & students' Thai listening and speaking skills for beginners. Around 40 international staff from various faculties together with international students signed up for this class; however, due to limited number of seats, only 29 people were allowed to take this course. The class is being taught by Aj. Sophita Sukchuay, an FIS lecturer, on the 2nd floor of the Main Classrooms and Laboratories Building, (Bldg. 6), Room 6219. Only one class is currently being offered and will run for 4 months until the end of May. The class is held every Wednesday from 16.30 - 18.30 hrs.



FEBRUARY 22: A VISIT FROM THE SCHOOL OF MANAGEMENT, ASIAN INSTITUTE OF TECHNOLOGY, THAILAND (AIT)

On February 22nd, 2018, Asst. Prof. Dr. Nuwan Thapthiang, Dean of Faculty of International Studies and Asst. Prof. Dr. Apichat Heednacram, Assistant President for Global Relations welcomed delegates from Asian Institute of Technology (AIT) School of Management, Thailand to PSU Phuket. The purpose of this visit was to promote scholarship opportunities. AIT is offering up to 25 full scholarships to qualified graduating students in their full-time MBA Program. The scholarship fundings will be provided through a combination of AIT fellowship programs and the Royal Thai Government (RTG) supported fund programs. These scholarships cover all MBA tuition and registration fees. The scholarships will be awarded to PSU graduating students who meet a minimum of 2.75 GPA and other criteria. Additionally, 10 Partial Fellowships are available for international students covering 50 percent of the MBA tuition and registration fees. These will be awarded to PSU graduating international students who meet a minimum of 2.75 GPA and other criteria.
