- Endeavour Vocational Education and Training Scholarships
- Endeavour Executive Fellowship (Professional Development)

## HOLIDAYS IN MAY

## THURSDAY 5 MAY: CORONATION DAY

This day is a public holiday commemorating the coronation of King Bhumibol Adulyadej in 1950.

## FRIDAY 6 MAY: EXTRA HOLIDAY

## MONDAY 9 MAY: ROYAL PLOUGHING CEREMONY DAY

This public holiday is to commemorate the beginning of the rice growing season. The ceremony is of Hindu origin. In the ceremony, two sacred oxen plough a groove in ceremonial ground while Hindu priests (Brahmins) sow rice seeds. The oxen are then offered plates of food, including rice, corn, green beans, sesame, fresh-cut grass, water and rice whisky. Depending on what the oxen eat, court astrologers and Brahmins make a prediction on whether the coming growing season will be plentiful or not. The ceremony is held to guarantee a good harvest.

#### FRIDAY 20 MAY: VISAKHA BUCHA DAY

Visakha Bucha Day in Buddhism commemorates the birth, enlightenment and the passing away of Gautama Buddha. The Buddha was born on this day in Lumpini, Nepal. 35 years later on this day he attained enlightenment in Buddhagaya, India. And 80 years after his birth, on the same day, the Buddha passed away in Kusinara (Kushinagar), India. On Visakha Bucha Day, Buddhists offer alms to monks, visit temples, make merit, and observe meditation. The day is also a reminder to Buddhists of the Buddha's most important teachings.

## 90 DAY REPORT ONLINE!

Must be done 8 - 15 days <u>BEFORE</u> the 90 day due date stamped in your passport.

On the IAC website (<u>http://www.iac.phuket.psu.ac.th/</u>) under "**MEDIA**" you can find a link titled "**Online 90 Day Report Instructions**" to guide you to doing the online 90 day report. You can also contact IAC for further information and if you have any questions.

IMPORTANT: INTERNATIONAL STAFF AND FULL TIME STUDENTS, DON'T FORGET TO CHECK YOUR PASSPORT TO SEE WHEN YOU MUST DO YOUR <u>90 DAY REPORT</u> EITHER ONLINE (8-15 DAYS BEFORE DUE DATE) OR AT THE IMMIGRATION OFFICE IN PHUKET TOWN.
