RECENT EVENTS:

AUGUST 27 - 28: TOEIC POST-TEST

On August 27th - 28th, 2018 under *the Internationalization Development Project*, IAC in coordination with Personnel Office administered *TOEIC post-test* to PSU Phuket supporting staff who have attended the four-month TOEIC preparation course that ran from April 30 - August 28, 2018 at the Main Classroom and Laboratories Building in Room 6307 to conclude the project. The two-day test consisted of a listening & reading test of 100 questions each with a group of 50 PSU Phuket supporting staff in attendance. The TOEIC preparation classes were taught by Aj. Milla Budiarto, an IAC international staff, on Monday - Thursday from 15.30 - 17.00 hrs. in Room 6113. The classes were divided into 2 groups based on the staff's TOEIC pre-test scores and met twice a week for 1.5 hours each class.

90 DAY REPORT ONLINE!

Must be done 8 - 15 days **BEFORE** the 90 day due date stamped in your passport.

On the IAC website (http://www.iac.phuket.psu.ac.th/) under "Useful Information" you can find a link titled "Online 90 Day Report In**structions**" to guide you to do the online 90 day report. You can also contact IAC for further information and if you have any questions.

IMPORTANT: FULL-TIME INTERNATIONAL STAFF AND STUDENTS. PLEASE REMEMBER TO CHECK YOUR PASSPORT TO SEE WHEN YOU MUST DO YOUR 90 DAY REPORT EITHER ONLINE (8-15 DAYS BEFORE DUE DATE) OR AT THE IMMIGRATION OFFICE IN PHUKET TOWN.
