APRIL 10: MEETING FOR PSU PHUKET FIELD HOSPITAL WITH PHUKET GOVERNOR FOR COVID-19

On April 10, 2020, Assoc. Prof. Pun Tongchumnum, Ph.D., Vice President for Phuket Campus; Assoc. Prof. Puttisak Puttawibul, M.D., Dean of Faculty of Medicine, PSU Hatyai Campus; and Assoc. Prof. Roengsak Leetanaporn, M.D., Vice Dean for Hospital Affairs and Hospital Director, PSU Hatyai Campus attended a meeting with the Phuket governor as well as the head of various government departments and other relevant persons at Kosimbee Meeting Room, Phuket City Hall. The meeting was to inform and discuss the preparation for the second field hospital at PSU Phuket Campus in response to the COVID-19 outbreak in Phuket. In addition, PSU is ready with medical team of doctors, nurses, and other related personnel from the Faculty of Medicine, who are ready to perform their duties on April 15, 2020.



APRIL 15: WELCOMING THE MEDICAL TEAM FROM THE FACULTY OF MEDICINE, PSU HATYAI CAMPUS

On April 15, 2020, the Phuket governor along with the vice governors; heads of various governmental institutions; and PSU Phuket Campus vice presidents, deans, and other representatives; warmly welcomed a medical team of 58 people including doctors, nurses, and healthcare professionals from the Faculty of Medicine, PSU Hatyai Campus at Phuket International Airport. On May 15, 2020, Assoc. Prof. Pun Tongchumnum, Ph.D., vice president of PSU Phuket, and Assoc. Prof. Puttisak Puttawibul, M.D., dean of Faculty of Medicine, met with Phuket Governor Phakaphong Tavipatana and Mr. Nathee Thinsakhu, Phuket Member of Parliament, to report on the operational progress of Prince of Songkla Hospital, Phuket Campus (second field hospital). The hospital has temporarily ceased treatment of COVID-19 patients due to improved outbreak situation in Phuket. All equipment and facilities will remain in the hospital in case of a new outbreak. In the early morning, PSU Phuket hosted an Appreciation Event and invited many local government representatives, public and private organizations, and distinguished guests including the mayors from Kathu, Muang Phuket, and Patong. The event was organized to thank the medical team of doctors and nurses who have fulfilled their honorable duties and dedicated their service for a month to assist and take care of COVID-19 patients at PSU Phuket hospital (2nd field hospital).

During this event, PSU Phuket and the public and private sectors agreed to work together to implement a healthcare policy that serves the people in the Andaman to fulfill the urgent needs in the area.

Immigration Matters Reminder

As a foreign national living in Thailand, it is your responsibility to always follow and obey the Thai Immigration rules and regulations. IAC is here to provide support and assistance and shall not be held responsible or liable for any fees incurred due to your negligence.

Entry stamp:
Always double-check the visa type and expiry date on the entry stamp in your passport every time you go through the immigration counter at the airport to make sure you get the correct stamp.

Visa and Extension of Stay: Note your visa (figure 1) or extension of stay (figure 2) expiry date and notify IAC two weeks before the expiry date to get an extension of stay based on education or employment.
 FINE: 500 baht per day with a maximum of 20,000 baht for overstaying. If you overstay more than 90 days, you will be deported and banned from re-entering Thailand.

90-day reporting: Holders of single-entry visa (figure 1) or extension of stay (figure 2) must report to the Immigration Office every 90 days in person 15 days before to 7 days after the due date) or via online (between 7-15 days before the due date).
 FINE: 2,000 baht for late reporting up to 5,000 baht if you get arrested.

Holders of multiple-entry visa do not need to do this but must leave Thailand every 90 days instead.
 FINE: 500 baht overstay fee per day if fail to exit Thailand after the 90th day.

Address registration update:
 You must update your address registration within 24 hours of arrival when you: a) exit and re-enter Thailand, or b) move to a new place of residence, or c) stay at a place other than your registered residence for any overnight stays even for only one night. Keep the proof of registration in your passport at all times.

If you live on campus: register your address at IAC. FINE: You and your landlord may be fined and you will be denied any services (e.g. 90-day reporting, re-entry permit and extension of stay applications) at the Immigration Office.

Exchange students: register your address at IAC.

Re-entry permit: Holders of single-entry visa (figure 1) or extension of stay (figure 2) must always apply for a re-entry permit at the Immigration Office before leaving Thailand.

Holders of multiple-entry visa can exit Thailand without obtaining this permit.

WARNING: Exiting Thailand without this permit will automatically invalidate your single-entry visa or extension of stay. You will get a 30-day visa exemption stamp instead when you re-enter Thailand. As a result, you have to leave Thailand again to apply for a new non-immigrant visa.

Extension of Stay Cancellation: Holders of single-entry visa (figure 1) with an extension of stay (figure 2) must cancel their extension of stay at the Phuket Town Immigration Office if they no longer work or study at PSU Phuket, effective on the last day of work or study.

WARNING: Letting the extension of stay expire on its own and/or leaving the country without canceling it DOES NOT automatically cancel your extension of stay. Failure to cancel your extension of stay will result in your future extension of stay application being denied by the Immigration Office. You may also be fined with overstay fee if you stayed in Thailand after the last date of your employment or study.

作为居住在泰国的外籍人士，您有责任始终遵守泰国移民局的相关法律法规。IAC（国际事务处）将为您提供支持和帮助，但不为因您个人疏忽而产生的任何后果承担责任。

入境章：
每次离开机场的入境柜台前，请仔细检查护照上的签证类型和入境章上所列明的有效期，确保签证信息正确。

签证及延期停留许可：请注意您的签证类型（如图1）及延期停留许可（如图2）的有效期，并在期满前两周通知IAC，以便我们为办理留学或工作延期停留许可。

罚款：逾期停留将被处以每日500泰铢的罚款，最高可处20000泰铢。如逾期超过90天，将被驱逐出境，并禁止再次入境泰国。

90天报告：持单次入境签证（如图1）或延期停留许可（如图2）的人士，须每90天亲自（到期前15天至到期后7天内）或通过网络（到期前7至15天）向当地移民局进行报告。
 罚款：如果在规定期限内进行90天报告，您将处以2000泰铢的罚款；如因未报告，最高可处5000泰铢。

持多次入境签证的人士无须履行90天报告，但必须每90天从泰国出境一次。
 罚款：如未按规定在90天内从泰国出境，您将处以每日500泰铢的逾期停留罚款。

地址登记：
您必须在入境泰国后的24小时内向相关部门登记您的住址，包含以下三种情况：（1）出境后重新入境泰国；（2）搬到新的居住地；（3）在您登记的常住地以外的地方过夜，即使过夜时间只有一晚。地址登记证明应附在您的护照上，请妥善保管。

如果您在宋卡王子大学普吉分校居住，请联系IAC。
 如果您不在校内居住，请联系您的房东在网上或由房东作为您在泰国的外籍人士，您将会被移民局拒绝入境并为您进行地址登记。
 国际交流生请到IAC进行地址登记。

再入境许可（回头签）：
持单次入境签证（如图1）或延期停留许可（如图2）的人士，请务必在离开泰国前前往当地移民局申请回头签。
 持多次入境签证人士无须申请回头签。

延期停留许可注册：
持有单次入境签证（如图1）且已有延期停留许可（如图2）的人士，如不再在宋卡王子大学普吉分校学习或工作，必须前往普吉镇移民局注册当前的延期停留许可，生效日为工作或学习期满的最后一天。

警告：如果您的延期停留许可已自动过期，或在未注册延期停留许可的情况下离开泰国，您的延期停留许可并不会被泰国移民局自动注销。未按规定注册的人士，移民局将拒绝您日后入境泰国的延期停留许可申请。如果您在工作或学习期满后仍留在泰国，您将会被处以罚款并支付逾期停留费用。

REMEMBER ME IN 90 DAYS REPORT ONLINE!

Must be done 15 days BEFORE the 90 day due date stamped in your passport.

IMPORTANT: Full-time International Staff and Students, please remember to check your passport to see when you must DO your 90 day report EITHER ONLINE (15 days before due date) or at the Immigration Office in Phuket Town.
