JUNE 6: PSU PHUKET MOVES FORWARD WITH THE STRATEGY TO ESTABLISH THE ANDAMAN INTERNATIONAL HEALTH CENTER

On June 6th, 2020, Prince of Songkla University, Phuket Campus hosted the PSU Phuket Campus Promotion Committee meeting to summarize the results of PSU Phuket Hospital (2nd field hospital) operation during the COVID-19 crisis in Phuket. The meeting also further discussed about the plan to establish the Andaman International Health Center according to the University Council policy.

This health center consists of the Andaman International College of Health, PSU Phuket Hospital, and Wellness Center. The Andaman International College of Health will provide short-term and long-term courses for students. The College will begin accepting nursing students in academic year 2020 and both dentistry and medical technology students in academic year 2022.

In the meeting, PSU Phuket management team, the Faculty of Medicine representatives, engineers, and other relevant parties agreed to renovate the areas of PSU Phuket Sports Complex for further use. According to the plan, the PSU Phuket Hospital is expected to be operational within 3 years with 150 beds capacity and approximately 600 outpatients a day.

At this meeting, the Chairman of the Promotion Committee, the Honorable Committee of Prince of Songkla University Senate, Mr. Banyan Chansen, expressed his admiration on the progress made by PSU Phuket Campus.

- Have a high school diploma or IGCSE (International General Certificate of Secondary Education), GED (General Educational Development), or IB (International Baccalaureate)
- A certificate of English Proficiency Test (for non-native English speakers) not older than 2 years
 - > TOEFL score:
 - >> Paper-based: 477
 - >> Computer-based: 153
 - >> Internet-based: 53
 - > IELTS band score 4.5
 - > TOEIC score 550
- Pass admission interview

Application Procedure

- Completed Application Form
- A certified copy of high school diploma and transcript of records or a certified copy of one of the following certificates: IGCSE, GED, or IB
- A certificate of English Proficiency Test result (TOEIC/TOEFL/IELTS)
- A certified copy of main passport page showing personal details
- A certified copy of name/surname change certificate (if applicable)
- 2-inch recent photograph

Entry Requirement

- Have a bachelor's or master's degree
- A certificate of English Proficiency Test (for non-native English speakers) not older than 2 years:
 - > TOEFL score
 - >> Paper-based: 500
 - >> Computer-based: 173
 - > IELTS band score: 6.1
- Other supporting documents required depending on the program.

SUNDAY, JULY 5: ASANHA BUCHA DAY

Also known as Dharma Day, this day celebrates the Buddha's first sermon where he shared the doctrine that he received following his enlightenment. This first sermon includes the teachings of the four noble truths: there is suffering, suffering is caused by craving, there is a state beyond suffering and craving; and finally, the way to nirvana is via the eightfold path. On this day Buddhists donate offerings to temples and listen to sermons.

MONDAY, JULY 6: BUDDHIST LENT DAY

This public holiday is to commemorate the beginning of the rice growing season. The ceremony is of Hindu origin. In the ceremony, two sacred oxen plough a groove in ceremonial ground while Hindu priests (Brahmins) sow rice seeds. The oxen are then offered plates of food, including rice, corn, green beans, sesame, fresh-cut grass, water and rice whisky. Depending on what the oxen eat, court astrologers and Brahmins make a prediction on whether the coming growing season will be plentiful or not. The ceremony is held to guarantee a good harvest.

TUESDAY, JULY 7: SUBSTITUTION FOR ASANHA BUCHA DAY

The day commemorates the birthday of the King of Thailand, Vajiralongkorn, is held annually on 28th July. Known as Rama X, King Vajiralongkorn has reigned Thailand since 13 October 2016. He is the only son of King Bhumibol Adulyadej and Queen Sirikit.

As a foreign national living in Thailand, it is your responsibility to always follow and obey the Thai Immigration rules and regulations. IAC is here to provide support and assistance and shall not be held responsible or liable for any fees incurred due to your negligence.

Entry stamp:
 Always double-check the visa type and expiry date on the entry stamp in your passport every time you go through the immigration counter at the airport to make sure you get the correct stamp.

Visa and Extension of Stay: Note your visa (figure 1) or extension of stay (figure 2) expiry date and notify IAC two weeks before the expiry date to get an extension of stay based on education or employment.
 FINE: 500 baht per day with a maximum of 20,000 baht for overstaying. If you overstay more than 90 days, you will be deported and banned from re-entering Thailand.

90-day reporting: Holders of single-entry visa (figure 1) or extension of stay (figure 2) must report to the Immigration Office every 90 days in person 15 days before to 7 days after the due date) or via online (between 7-15 days before the due date).
 FINE: 2,000 baht for late reporting up to 5,000 baht if you get arrested.

Holders of multiple-entry visa do not need to do this but must leave Thailand every 90 days instead.
 FINE: 500 baht overstay fee per day if fail to exit Thailand after the 90th day.

Address registration update:
 You must update your address registration within 24 hours of arrival when you: a) exit and re-enter Thailand, or b) move to a new place of residence, or c) stay at a place other than your registered residence for any overnight stays even for only one night. Keep the proof of registration in your passport at all times.

If you live on campus: register your address at IAC. **FINE:** You and your landlord may be fined and you will be denied any services (e.g. 90-day reporting, re-entry permit and extension of stay applications) at the Immigration Office.

Exchange students: register your address at IAC.

Re-entry permits: Holders of single-entry visa (figure 1) or extension of stay (figure 2) must always apply for a re-entry permit at the Immigration Office before leaving Thailand.

Holders of multiple-entry visa can exit Thailand without obtaining this permit.
WARNING: Exiting Thailand without this permit will automatically invalidate your single-entry visa or extension of stay. You will need a 30-day visa exemption stamp instead when you re-enter Thailand. As a result, you have to leave Thailand again to apply for a new non-immigrant visa.

作为居住在泰国的外籍人士，您有责任始终遵守泰国移民局的相关法律法规。IAC（国际事务处）将为您提供支持和帮助，但不为因您个人疏忽而产生的任何费用承担责任。

入境章:
 每次离开机场的入境柜台前，请仔细检查护照上的签证类型和入境章上所列的有效期，确保签证信息正确。

签证及延期停留许可: 请注意您的签证类型(如图1)及延期停留许可(如图2)的有效期，并在期满前两周通知IAC，以便我们为贵方办理延期或工作延期停留许可。
罚款: 逾期停留将被处以每日500泰铢的罚款，最高可处20000泰铢。如逾期超过90天，将被驱逐出境，并禁止再次进入泰国。

90天报告: 持单次入境签证(如图1)或延期停留许可(如图2)的人士，须每90天亲自(到期前15天至到期后7天内)或通过网络(到期前7至15天)向当地移民局进行报告。
罚款: 如果在规定期限内进行90天报告，您将被处以2000泰铢的罚款；如因此被拘留，最高可处5000泰铢。

持多次入境签证的人士无须进行90天报告，但必须每90天从泰国出境一次。
罚款: 如未按规定进行90天报告，您将被处以每日500泰铢的逾期停留罚款。

地址登记:
 您必须在入境泰国后的24小时内向相关部门登记您的住址，包含以下三种情况: (1) 出境后重新入境泰国; (2) 搬到新的居住地; (3) 在您登记的常住地以外的地方过夜，即使过夜时间只有一晚。地址登记证明应附在您的护照上，请妥善保管。

如在宋卡王子大学宿舍分校居住，请联系IAC。
罚款: 如果您和房东未在网站上或由您不在校内居住，请联系您的房东在网上或由您不在泰国的外籍人士，您将会被移民局拒绝其本人到移民局为贵方进行地址登记。
罚款: 如未按时进行地址登记，您将被处以每日500泰铢的逾期停留罚款。

再入境许可(回头签):
 持单次入境签证(如图1)或延期停留许可(如图2)的人士，请务必在离开泰国前前往当地移民局申请回头签。
持多次入境签证人士无须申请回头签。

延期停留许可注册:
 持有单次入境签证(如图1)且已有延期停留许可(如图2)的人士，如不再在宋卡王子大学宿舍分校学习或工作，必须前往当地移民局注册当前的延期停留许可，生效日为工作或学习期间的最后一日。

警告: 如果您的延期停留许可已自动过期，或在您未注册延期停留许可的情况下离开泰国，您的延期停留许可将不会获泰国移民局自动注册。未按规定注册的人士，移民局将在您日后入境泰国时拒绝您的延期停留许可申请。如您在工作或学习期间之后仍留在泰国，您将会被处以罚款并支付逾期停留费用。



90 DAY REPORT ONLINE!

Must be done 15 days BEFORE the 90 day due date stamped in your passport.

IMPORTANT: Full-time International Staff and Students, please remember to check your passport to see when you must DO your 90 day report EITHER ONLINE (15 days before due date) or at the Immigration Office in Phuket Town.
