On December 19th, 2020 IAC staff picked up the students from Guokai Education Group from China at Phuket International Airport to study full time at PSU Phuket. On December 21st, 2020, Asst. Prof. Pensiri Akkajit, Ph.D., Assistant President for International Affairs, Dr. Pittaya Limbut, FIS lecturer and IAC staff warmly welcomed new Guokai full-time students at the Meeting Room, 3rd floor of the President's Office Building (Bldg. 7). Around 15 people attended this orientation and IAC staff gave presentations about PSU Phuket campus life, safety and cultural tips, and immigration information. The orientation was concluded with a group photo and a campus tour. On December 21st-24th, 2020, IAC staff assisted the new students such as opening bank accounts, buying student uniform and accessories, taking student photos, paying for the student dormitory, and shopping for essential things at shopping malls.



JANUARY 4 & 6: ORIENTATION FOR NEW INTERNATIONAL STUDENTS

On January 4th & 6th, 2021 IAC gave an introductory presentation about PSU Phuket and immigration information for a group of 13 new international students both full time & exchange who will be studying at PSU Phuket for a few years & a semester. The full time students are from Japan doing 2+2 program, the exchange students are from Belgium, Finland, Ireland and Switzerland under the International Study Programme, Phuket (ISPP) and other student exchange programs. The IAC also organized a short campus as part of the orientation program visiting the offices and facilities on campus, as well as purchasing student uniforms and accessories in Phuket Town.



JANUARY 19: 9TH BOARD MEETING OF THE CONFUCIUS INSTITUTE AT PHUKET AND MOU SIGN-ING CEREMONY BETWEEN SHANGHAI UNIVERSITY AND PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, PHUKET CAMPUS

On January 19th, 2021, the Confucius Institute at Phuket (CIP) hosted a virtual 9th Board Meeting of the Confucius Institute at Phuket and an MOU signing ceremony between Shanghai University (SHU) and PSU Phuket. The board meeting was officially opened with welcoming speeches given by Prof. Gong Siyi, Vice President of SHU and Chairperson for CIP Board of Advisors, and followed by Assoc. Prof. Pun Thongchumnum, Ph.D., Vice President for PSU Phuket Campus. Around 10 people attended this online meeting including the committees and representatives from both universities. During the meeting, Dr. Yang Wenbo, Director of CIP, presented the 2020 annual report & 2021 work plan, as well as discussed about further collaboration such as master's degree program in international trade. The virtual meeting was concluded with an MOU Signing Ceremony between the two universities. The MOU focuses on Chinese language teaching programs and related studies, language and cultural exchange activities, training Chinese language teachers, developing Chinese language education resources, organizing accreditation tests on Chinese language and culture, and other related activities/academic support. The virtual meeting was officially closed after the closing speech given by the Chairperson and a group photo taking from both universities.



JANUARY 20 & 27: HALF-DAY PHUKET SIGHTSEEING EXCURSION

On January 20th & 27th, 2021, IAC organized a half-day trip in Phuket visiting tourist attractions such as: Nai Harn Beach, Promthep Cape, the Big Bud-

dha and Kata Beach. Each trip was limited to 14 international students and accompanied by 2 IAC staff using 2 PSU Phuket vans. We were lucky to have a nice weather on both trips so everybody can enjoy the sunshine and the beach.














Must be done 15 days **BEFORE** the 90 day due date stamped in your passport.
