# NOVEMBER 18: A DELEGATE FROM MULTIMEDIA UNIVERSITY, MALAYSIA, VISITED PSU PHUKET

Prof. Dr. Pun Thongchumnum, Vice President for PSU Phuket Campus; followed by videos from a representative from each faculty. Then, IAC also organized a short campus tour as part of the orientation program, visiting the offices and facilities on campus.



November 2022 - January 2023: PSU Phuket Young Global Affairs and Corporate Communication for the Sustainable Marine Life (PSU Young GACC) – PSU Open Mobility 2022 (Reinventing University Project – 2022)

From November 2022 – January 2023, PSU Phuket organized various activities for 16 Thai PSU Young GACC student ambassadors led by Asst. Prof. Dr. Pensiri Akkajit, head of project, and IAC staff. This year's project theme is "Sustainable Development Goal 14: Life Below Water." The acvitivies include:

1. On November 23rd, 2022 the students attended a special lecture on "Endangered Marine Species" given by Mr. Hirun Kanghae, Fisheries Expert from the Phuket Marine Biological Center (PMBC).

2. On December 9th, 2022 the students and their international buddies did a beach clean-up to collect plastics and other rubbish along Nai Yang Beach.

3. On November – December 2022 the students participated in a six-hour English for Effective Presentation Skills workshop taught by Aj. Milla Budiarto.

4. On January 13th-15th, 2023 the students took part in an educational trip to Singapore to visit St. John's Island National Marine Laboratory (SJINML) within the Tropical Marine Science Institute of National University of Singapore (NUS). During the three-day visit, the students had the opportunity to learn more about SJINML and what they do, attend a special talk by an Acoustic Research Laboratory Scientist, and tour the facilities in SJINML.



# JANUARY 17: DELEGATES FROM THE DEPARTMENT FOR INTERNATIONAL TRADE (DIT), BRITISH Embassy Bangkok, visited PSU Phuket

On January 17th, 2023 Ms. Ravipa Chongveruwon, DIT Deputy Director and her team from the Department for International Trade (DIT), British Embassy Bangkok, visited PSU Phuket at Meeting Room 2, 2nd floor of the President's Office Building, (Bldg.7). The honorable delegates were warmly welcomed by Assoc. Prof. Dr. Pun Thongchumnum, Vice President for PSU Phuket Campus; Dr. Tagsina Sripracha, Assistant President for International Affairs, Phuket Campus; faculty representatives, and IAC staff. # **IMMIGRATION RELATED MATTERS**

### Prince of Songkla University, **Phuket Campus**

### **VISA EXTENSION**

Students must apply for an extension of stay based on education at Phuket Immigration Office **before the visa expiry date**. Your permitted length of stay will be extended up to a maximum of one (1) year depending on your study period or only up to your passport expiry date if it expires in less than a year.

**Required documents:** Completed and signed TM. 7 and STM. 2 application forms at IAC

  Current visa/extension of stay
- Last entry stamp Departure Card (TM. 6)
- Up-to-date TM. 30 address registration Copy of your GPA from the previous semester (printed out from
- SIS) One recent passport-size photograph (2 inches/4x6 cm)
- Application fee: 1,900 baht

### Important:

You must notify IAC at least two weeks before your visa or extension of stay expires to apply for another extension of stay. You can apply for an extension of stay 45 days before the expiry date.

To an exercise Warning: Overstaying is illegal: Overstay fine is 500 baht per day with a maximum fine of 20,000 baht. If you overstay more than 90 days, you will be deported and banned from re-entering Thailand.

### **RE-ENTRY PERMIT**

dents must apply for a re-entry permit at the Immigration Office before exiting Thailand to go abroad. The re-entry permit will be valid until the expiry date of your single-entry visa or extension of stay.

### There are 2 types of re-entry permit:

ingle re-entry permit: you can use only one time. The fee for a ingle re-entry permit is 1,000 baht.

Multiple re-entry permit: you can use multiple times within your visa or extension of stay validity period. The fee for a multiple re-entry permit is 3,800 baht.

If you don't apply for a re-entry permit before leaving the country your visa will be automatically invalid.

### ADDRESS REGISTRATION (TM.30)

Address registration is a report of your address to the Immigration Office within 24 hours of arrival. If your address registration is not updated, you will not be allowed to do your 90-day reporting and vise extension.

If you live on campus: IAC will register your address via the immigration website. Please bring your passport together with the departure card (T.M.6) to the IAC office.

### If you live off campus:

- You live off campus: lease contact your landlord and prepare these documents: Passport (with copied pages) Completed TM. 30 application form Signed copy of the landlord's 10 card Signed copy of the property title deed (house book) Signed copy of the ronperty title deed (house book) Signed copy of the rental contract Power of Attorney Letter affixed with 10 baht tax stamp if reporting on behalf of the landlord

- When you arrive in Phuket, please contact the IAC or your
- landlord to register your address You also have re-register your address within 24 hours of arrival
- when you exit and enter Thailand

  - you move to a new place of residence You staying at a place other than your registered residence for any overnight stays such as staying at hotels.



# REPORT **ONLINE!**

Must be done 15 days **BEFORE** the 90 day due date stamped in your passport.

### **IMPORTANT:**

please remember to check your passport to see when you must DO your <u>90</u> day report EITHER ONLINE (15 days before due date) or at the Immigration Office in Phuket Town.
