RECENT EVENTS

SEPTEMBER 1: DELEGATES FROM RMIT UNIVERSITY, AUSTRALIA, VISITED PSU PHUKET

On September 1st, 2022 Dr. Jayani Chandrapala, Senior Lecturer and students from the Royal Melbourne Institute of Technology (RMIT), Australia, visited PSU Phuket at Ket-Ho Meeting Room, 5th floor of the President's Office Building, (Bldg.7). The delegates were warmly welcomed by Assoc. Prof. Prathana Kannaovakun, Ph.D., Vice President for Academic Affairs, Phuket Campus and representatives from the faculties and IAC. During the meeting, IAC showed a video introduction about Phuket campus and followed by a presentation about RMIT University given by Dr. Jayani Chandrapala. The purpose of this visit was to discuss the potential future collaboration opportunities between RMIT and PSU Phuket such as joint research, staff exchanges, PhD scholarships, workshops, 2+1 joint degrees and also engaging both RMIT and PSU students in industry-based projects in Australia and Thailand. The visiting RMIT students also briefly introduced themselves and shared their thoughts about this visit. The program was concluded with a gift exchange and commemorative photo-taking.

VISA EXTENSION ASSISTANCE FOR INTERNATIONAL STAFF AND STUDENTS (EVERY MONTH)

IAC provides visa extension assistance for all international staff and students. IAC must be notified by the visa holder at least two weeks before the visa expiry date in order to apply for an extension of stay. The visa extension can be done 45 days before the expiry date.

WARNING: OVERSTAYING YOUR VISA IS ILLEGAL! IF YOU OVERSTAY, THERE IS A FINE OF 500 BAHT PER DAY WITH A MAXIMUM FINE OF 20,000 BAHT. IF YOU OVERSTAY MORE THAN 90 DAYS, YOU WILL BE DEPORTED AND BANNED FROM RE-ENTERING THAILAND.

IMMIGRATION RELATED MATTERS

Prince of Songkla University, **Phuket Campus**



VISA EXTENSION

Students must apply for an extension of stay based on education at Phuket Immigration Office before the visa expiry date. Your permitted length of stay will be extended up to a maximum of one (1) year depending on your study period or only up to your passport expiry date if it expires in less than a year.

Required documents:

- Completed and signed TM. 7 and STM. 2 application forms at IAC
- Completed and signed TM. 7 at Office
 Signed photocopies of:
 Passport (main page)
 Current visa/extension of stay
- Last entry stamp
- Departure Card (TM. 6)
- Up-to-date TM. 30 address registration
- Copy of your GPA from the previous semester (printed out from
- One recent passport-size photograph (2 inches/4x6 cm)
- Application fee: 1,900 baht

You must notify IAC at least two weeks before your visa or extension of stay expires to apply for another extension of stay. You can apply for an extension of stay 45 days before the expiry date.

Warning:

Overstaying is illegal!

Overstay fine is 500 baht per day with a maximum fine of 20,000 baht. If you overstay more than 90 days, you will be deported and banned from re-entering Thailand.

RE-ENTRY PERMIT

dents must apply for a re-entry permit at the Immigration Office before exiting Thailand to go abroad.

The re-entry permit will be valid until the expiry date of your single-entry visa or extension of stay.

There are 2 types of re-entry permit:

ingle re-entry permit: you can use only one time. The fee for a ingle re-entry permit is 1,000 baht.

Multiple re-entry permit: you can use multiple times within your visa or extension of stay validity period. The fee for a multiple re-entry permit is 3,800 baht.



If you don't apply for a re-entry permit before leaving the country your visa will be automatically invalid.



ADDRESS REGISTRATION (TM.30)

Address registration is a report of your address to the Immigration Office within 24 hours of arrival. If your address registration is not updated, you will not be allowed to do your 90-day reporting and visa extension.

If you live on campus:

IAC will register your address via the immigration website. Please bring your passport together with the departure card (T.M.6) to the IAC office.

If you live off campus:

 Completed TM. 30 application form

 Signed copy of the landlord's 10 card

 Signed copy of the landlord's 10 card

 Signed copy of the property title deed (house book)

 Signed copy of the rental contract

 Power of Attorney Letter affixed with 10 baht tax stamp if reporting on behalf of the landlord

When you arrive in Phuket, please contact the IAC or your landlord to register your address You also have re-register your address within 24 hours of arrival

- you exit and enter Thailand
- you move to a new place of residence You staying at a place other than your registered residence for any overnight stays such as staying at hotels.



90 DAY REPORT **ONLINE!**

Must be done 15 days **BEFORE** the 90 day due date stamped in your passport.

IMPORTANT:

please remember to check your passport to see when you must DO your <u>90</u> day report EITHER ONLINE (15 days before due date) or at the Immigration Office in Phuket Town.
