



MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN PRINCE OF SONGKLA UNIVERSITY, TRANG CAMPUS AND CREST RESORT AND POOL VILLAS

Prince of Songkla University, Trang (hereinafter referred to as "PSU"), and Crest Resort and Pool Villas (hereinafter referred to as "CREST") agree to conclude the Memorandum of Understanding (hereinafter referred to as "MOU") with the key objective of promoting cooperative support and work-integrated education.

Article I: Principle of Cooperation

PSU and CREST agree to develop their academic collaborations under the principle of mutual understanding, mutual benefits, common interests, and mutually complementary activities.

Article II: Objectives of Cooperation

- (1) to promote collaborations in terms of teaching, research, and cultural activities;
- (2) to develop and encourage joint research seminars, conferences, workshops;
- (3) to assist each other in obtaining external funding from outside sources,
- (4) to provide the opportunities for job training, co-operative education, workshops as mutually agreed;
- (5) to support the exchange of academic resources/ materials;
- (6) to share experiences and expertise concerning university administration and management, and
- (7) to encourage other academic activities that both parties agree to be of mutual benefits.

Article III: Areas of Cooperation

Areas of cooperation can include any academic missions or other programs offered by PSU and CREST.

Article IV: Implementation

It is understood and agreed that:

- (1) Proposals for collaboration under this MOU will be submitted through the Chief Executive Officer of each party, and it is recommended that the written reports based on this collaboration should be submitted to each of the Chief Executive Officer at the completion of each project;

Article V: Duration and Termination of the Agreement


- (1) This MOU is effective as of the date of signature by the Chief Executive Officer of each of the participating party.
- (2) This MOU may be amended at any time as indicated by a written mutual consent.
- (3) This MOU may be terminated by either party by the provision of a written notice of termination not less than three (3) months prior to the desired termination date; however, both parties agree that all continuing obligations to students, or other entities, are met in full after the notice of termination.
